First three places will be announced in this Category.

Slovak Junior Amateur Championship /international/

1. Men U21 International Slovak Junior Amateur Championship (stroke play)

3. Men U18 International Slovak Junior Amateur Championship (stroke play)
4. Ladies U18 International Slovak Junior Amateur Championship (stroke play)
5. Boys U16 International Slovak Junior Amateur Championship (stroke play)

First places only will be announced in this Category.

Entry Conditions

Eligible are amateur players who are members of SKGA or another National Federation and have EGA handicap not exceeding **7,0** for Men and **10,0** for Ladies. HCP limit for members of SKGA is **15**. All players must fulfill the handicap criteria. Maximum entries: **144 (87 Men, 57 Ladies, from that at least 40 Men and 24 Ladies home members of SKGA)**. If there are more entries than 144 (87 Men and 57 Ladies) men and ladies with lower handicaps will be taken.

The Championship Committee retains the right to revise the criteria in special cases.

Technical Conditions

The Championship will be decided by strokes over three rounds of 18 holes each, in accordance to the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and to the Local Rules approved by the Championship Committee.

Committee has the right to change the Hole number of stipulated round in case of bad weather conditions.

Tees

Men – Black, Ladies – Yellow

Online scoring

Golf Genius app – The players are obliged to record score online to the Golf genius app and on the paper score card too.

Caddie (Rule 10.3)

A player is allowed to have a caddie during the stipulated round. Caddie must not be a PRO and can not be older than 21 years.

Spectators

The spectators may go with the group, but they cannot communicate with the players. Distance from the group at least 40 m. Spectators and parents are not allowed to perform the function of walking forecadies on the course. They must not enter the greens and must follow the instructions of the referees and organizers. The competition committee has the right to restrict the movement of spectators on the course

Prompt pace of play (Rule 5.6)

A round of golf is meant to be played at a prompt pace.

Each player should recognize that his or her pace of play is likely to affect how long it will take other players to play their rounds, including both those in the player's own group and those in following groups.

Players are encouraged to allow faster groups to play through.

(1) Pace of Play Recommendations. The player should play at a prompt pace throughout the round, including the time taken to:

- Prepare for and make each stroke,
- Move from one place to another between strokes, and
- Move to the next teeing area after completing a hole.

A player should prepare in advance for the next stroke and be ready to play when it is his or her turn. When it is the player's turn to play:

- It is recommended that the player make the stroke in no more than 40 seconds after he or she is (or should be) able to play without interference or distraction, and
- The player should usually be able to play more quickly than that and is encouraged to do so.

Penalty for breach the Rule:

One bad time	verbal warning from a Rules Official.
Two bad times	one stroke penalty
Three bad times	two stroke penalty
Four bad times	disqualification

Distance measuring devices (Rule 4.3)

In this competition a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only.

Carts

Players are obliged to walk during stipulated round.

Cut

After two rounds: 50% Men (minimum 6 players) and 50% Ladies (minimum 6 players) in each category plus ties. Min 35% of Slovak players will play after the cut in each category (min. 3).

Decision of ties

In the event of a tie after four rounds, the winner shall be decided by a „sudden death“, play-off over holes which will be determined by the Championship Committee. The play-off shall start as soon as practicable after the final competitors have finished the round.

In case of tie for the next positions up to the third place, the places will be decided on the basis of better scores recorded for the final 18,9,6,3 or last hole in that order.

Practicing

Practice round – The second practice shot from the same position is allowed only in the case of a play to the green, if the first ended off the green and without undue delay of play.

Rule 5-2b is modified as follows :

A player must not practise on the competition course before or between rounds.

Players may practice only on practice ground during and between the stipulated rounds.

Committee is entitled to impose changes of conditions of play before tournament starts.

Protest

A player is entitled to lodge protest before final results will be announced.
